The Alice Paul Equality Awards are named in memory of Alice Stokes Paul (1885-1977). Born in Mt. Laurel, NJ, Alice Paul dedicated her life to the single cause of securing equal rights for all women. Alice Paul led the final campaign for women's right to vote. After the 1920 victory, she authored the Equal Rights Amendment and initiated gender equality principles in both the United Nations Charter and in the 1964 Civil Rights Act.

The Alice Paul Institute was created in 1985 to enhance public awareness of Paul's life and work. The Institute acquired Paulsdale, her Mt. Laurel birthplace, in 1990 and has developed Paulsdale as a women's history and leadership center. Paulsdale, a National Historic Landmark, was restored to appear as it did when Paul lived there, from 1885 to 1920.
